

- The ecobag contains a special growing media and a bag with bulbs.
- Use scissors to cut the bag open about 1 cm below the seal.
- Now open the seed bag and push the bulbs about 1 cm into the soil and cover the bulb slightly with soil.
- Place the bag on a small plate and water the ecobag carefully by pouring about 150 ml of lukewarm water into the bag.
- Place the bag in a warm and bright place and water regularly (about 50 ml of water every 4 to 5 days).
- After about 10 to 14 days the lucky clover will start to grow.
- After about 3 to 4 months the plant will start to bloom.
- The ecobag is 100% compostable and can be planted entirely into a regular pot after about 4 months.
